

# Attention Students



Be part of an exciting course offering for high school students in New Jersey. This spring, Rutgers will be offering a course about the children of 9/11 victims, and high school students can participate.

Running from January 19, 2011 to May 2, 2011, the Rutgers Department of Journalism and Media Studies will be offering a course that will examine what has happened to the children of victims of the Sept. 11, 2001 attacks on the World Trade Center. College students will be interviewing these children (some of who are now grown) and writing stories about them, taking photos, and making videos.

The stories will be featured in major New Jersey newspapers and online. High School students also can participate. If your adviser is a member of GSSPA, ask her or him to recommend you to be part of the scholastic school contingent. You will be connected to the online version of the college course, be given reading assignments, meet with professional editors, photographers and reporters from major New Jersey newspapers, and, best of all, have the chance to accompany the college students when they interview the children of 9/11. You may also be asked to write stories about the interviews, and you can use the stories in your high school newspaper. This course is being offered only once, and only 10 students can participate.

At the end of the course, you will receive a Certificate of Participation from Rutgers and the New Jersey Press Association. You can mention your participation on your college applications.
